

# I. Lake Wolfgangsee Service for the 5.2- and 10k-runners

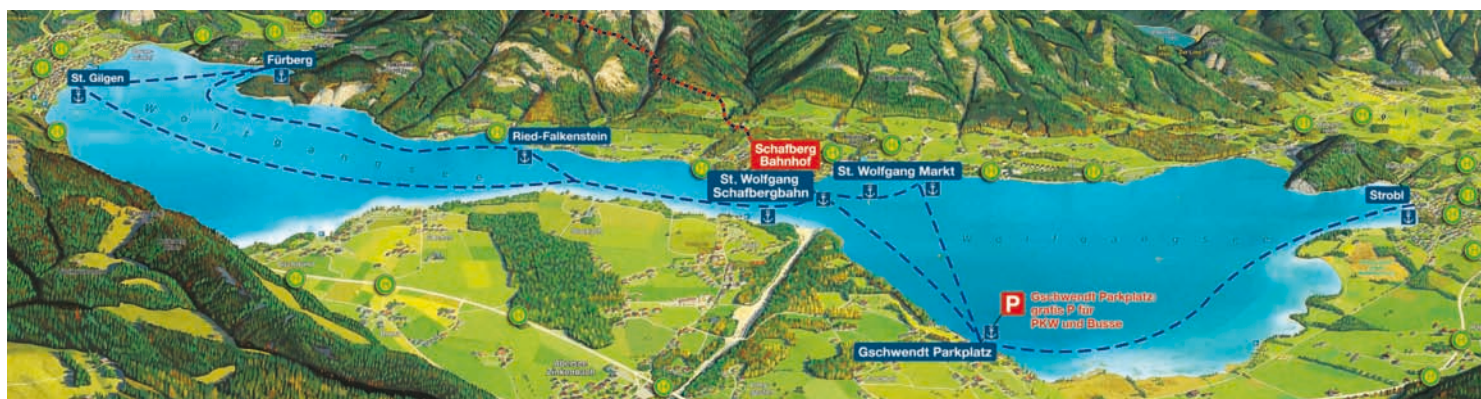
## With the Lake Wolfgangsee Boat Service to the starts in Strobl and Gschwendt

Wolfgangsee, 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020

Dear Runner,

in cooperation with the Lake Wolfgangsee Boat Company, a special service is offered on the 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 for the 49<sup>th</sup> International Lake Wolfgangsee Race (5.2 km Panorama Race- and 10 km Shoreline Race). All Panorama Race and Shoreline Race participants receive a voucher (in your starter-bag) for a picturesque and relaxing boat trip to Strobl (5.2 km starting place) or to Gschwendt (10 km starting place). Those accompanying runners can also use the boat service of course, (as far as capacity allows) at the official tarif.

- Runners can use the voucher found in the starting package either after the race (if you park free-of-charge in the starting places of Strobl oder Gschwendt) or before the race (if you park in St. Wolfgang / not for free).



**Tip 1:** Because parking in St. Wolfgang on race day is always extremely scarce, we advise those runners participating in the 5.2k and 10k races, to leave their vehicles at the free-of-charge car parks in Strobl or Gschwendt, compete in the race and then, after the event, return to the car park using the free boat trip.

There are two places to board boats in St. Wolfgang before or after the races – the Schafberg cog railway jetty (Schiffsanlegestelle Schafbergbahn) or at the jetty called „Markt“. **Special service**<sup>2020</sup>: Two extra boats (12.25/12.35 and 13.25/13.35) will bring you back to your starting place in Strobl or Gschwendt.

**Tip 2:** Use one of the first three boats to give yourself enough time to prepare unhurriedly for your 5.2k or 10k race.

- Please note:**
- The first boat (at 8.25 a.m.) is only for 5.2k-runners and it doesn't stop in St. Wolfgang Markt and Gschwendt.
  - Furthermore, boat 5 is only for very late arrivals. Boat 5 reaches Gschwendt and Strobl (**no garment bag service!**) very tight.

**Please note:** If you choose to collect your starting package for the 5.2k or 10k race on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 in Strobl or Gschwendt and/or you want to make a last-minute entry (only, if the race ist not booked out), please note the following time schedule:  
**Sunday, 8.00–10.00 a.m.:** 5.2k Number collection and 5.2k last-minute entries in the Tourist Office in Strobl.  
**Sunday, 7.30–9.30 a.m.:** 10k Number collection and 10k last-minute entries only at the start area in Gschwendt.  
 On Sunday **no** 10k and 5.2k Number collection and **no** 10 and 5.2k last-minute entries in St. Wolfgang!

**Tip 3:** We have organised the schedule so you have ample time to recuperate after the race and attend your respective award ceremony (2 p.m.: 5.2k / 2.45 p.m.: 10k / 3.30 p.m.: Team-Marathon / 3.45 p.m.: 27k / 4.45 p.m.: 42.195k).

+ After the race on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, boats will sail often from St. Wolfgang Markt jetty to Gschwendt and Strobl. Times – 11.50 a.m. / 12.35 p.m. / 12.50 p.m. / 1.35 p.m. / 1.50 p.m. / 2.50 p.m. / 3.50 p.m. / 4.50 p.m. / 5.50 p.m.

+ You can also board the same boats for the trip to Gschwendt and Strobl after the Lake Wolfgangsee Race and/or the award ceremonies at the Schafbergbahnhof (Schafberg cog railway boat jetty) some minutes earlier at 11.37 a.m. / 12.25 p.m. / 12.37 p.m. / 1.25 p.m. / 1.37 p.m. / 2.37 p.m. / 3.37 p.m. / 4.37 p.m. / 5.37 p.m.

## II. Lake Wolfgangsee Race Service for those accompanying runners

### This ist the best way to support your runner!

On the 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, we have especially adapted the timetable for those accompanying the runners and general spectators too: you can, for example, sail at 10.40 a.m. (10 minutes after the first start) from the 5.2k start in Strobl and at 10.45 a.m. (11 minutes after the first start) from the 10k start in Gschwendt directly to St. Wolfgang. Those accompanying runners can thus bring the runner's belongings to St. Wolfgang personally and hand them straight back at the finishing line!

**Please note:** Runners without accompaniment can, of course, use the free-of-charge clothing transport service provided by the event organisers (only with the provided, numbered plastic clothing-bags – no sports bags please). These clothing bags are to be handed in from 9.30 a.m. by 10.15 a.m. at the latest in the starting areas of Strobl and Gschwendt.

## III. Lake Wolfgangsee Race Service 2020 for all spectators

### Keeping track of the 49<sup>th</sup> International Lake Wolfgangsee Race by boat

Spectators who want to cheer on competitors during the race, can sail anywhere on the lake with the Lake Wolfgangsee Boat Service – for all events. Regardless of where you want to watch the racers as they pass through – either Ried, Fürberg, St. Gilgen, Gschwendt, Strobl or St. Wolfgang – you are always in the right place with the Lake Wolfgangsee Boat Service, and, in Fürberg, St. Gilgen, Gschwendt and Strobl, the atmosphere is always especially good, with music and commentary as the runners pass through. For those who have a love of natural beauty, we recommend a trip over to Gschwendt – where you can follow the race on the shores of picturesque Lake Wolfgangsee and return hourly from 11.40 a.m. until 5.40 p.m. to St. Wolfgang. From St. Gilgen you can go back hourly from 11.00 a.m..
