Dear Runner!

Welcome to the 49th International 27k Classic Race, 2020!

Please find below the most important information, set out clearly and concisely.

- 1. For your own good:** Before the race, please fill in your personal medical data on the back of your number.
- 2. Don't forget** – your health is the most important thing – don't risk anything. If you are not sure, that you are in a good shape, please visit our Medical Center in St. Wolfgang (for free).

Opening hours: Saturday, 17th October, 2020, 2–7 p.m. / Sunday, 18th October, 2020, 7.30–10 a.m.
3. Please check the official start list: entry errors (name, year of birth etc.) can still be corrected.
- 4. Timings:** Pentek timing (net time).
 - 2 UHF-Chips – at the backside of your starting number. Please fix the number outside.
 - Don't crease your number and don't coat something over your starting number!
 - No number outside, no timing.
5. Come to the welcome evening "**Griaß Eich!**" (vouchers in your starting package) on Saturday, 17th October, 2020 from 6 p.m.–8.30 p.m. in the Michael-Pacher-Haus in St. Wolfgang.
6. Women's changing facilities: Volksschule (primary school), St. Wolfgang and "Lichtsaaal" (Rathaus building).
Rear entrance from Florianigasse.
Men's changing facilities: Volksschule (primary school) and "Festsaal" (Rathaus building St. Wolfgang).
Rear entrance from Florianigasse.
7. Public toilets are available in the village centre – including in the primary school, the Rathaus building rear entrance, the multi storey car park and at the Schafbergbahn cog railway boat jetty.
8. Fasten your **starting number** on the front of your shirt – fix the number outside, otherwise timekeeping isn't possible.
- 9. 27k clothes bags:** Only with the officially numbered plastic-clothes bag – no personal sports' bags.
 - + Deposition of 27k clothes bags: Primary school 1st floor (9.30 a.m. until 10.15 a.m.).
 - + Return of 27k clothes bags: Primary school 1st floor (12 o'clock until 3.00 p.m.).
- 10. Starting line-up:** All starters must be behind the start line at 10.20 am at the latest!
Three staggered starts for the 27k race:
 - 10.30 a.m. – Block 1: envisaged finishing time 1:25:00–2:15:00 hours.
 - 10.34 a.m. – Block 2: envisaged finishing time 2:15:00–2:45:00 hours.
 - 10.38 a.m. – Block 3: envisaged finishing time 2:45:00–4:00:00 hours.

11. Spectator's boat trips: After the race starts there will be hourly spectator's boat trips from 10.50 a.m. from St. Wolfgang Markt to Gschwendt (17k).
Hourly returns from 11.40 a.m. from Gschwendt to St. Wolfgang Markt.
12. Respect each other! We ask that each 27k runner shows consideration when being overtaken by the faster marathon runners. Could all 27k runners please run on the right, leaving the left lane free (lakeside) for the marathon runners. THANK YOU!

- Except for 3k in Ried, all refreshment points have toilets available for runners.
14. **Injured – what now?** If you are only slightly injured, simply return (free of charge) to St. Wolfgang by boat with your start number. For more serious injuries, doctors and medics will be available.
15. **Exclusive Finisher's medal** – these are available immediately after your finish in St. Wolfgang.
Personal engraving (first name, surname, net time) is possible: Expo tent St. Wolfgang (€ 8,- or € 10,-).
16. **Massage:** Wolfgangsaal, (Pacher-Haus, St. Wolfgang, 1st floor).
17. Women's changing facilities and showers: Volksschule (primary school).
Women's and Mens' changing facilities: Rathaus St. Wolfgang, rear entrance.
Mens' showers: Volksschule (primary school), St. Wolfgang and nearby shower Porta cabins.
18. **Goodie bag:** Collecting only with your voucher (in starting bag) in the expo tent in St. Wolfgang before the race on Saturday (2 p.m.–7 p.m.) or on Sunday (7.30 a.m.–3.45 p.m.).
Content for example: Energy Cake bar, Recheis noodles ...
19. **27k Classic Award Ceremony:** 3.45 p.m. in the Michael-Pacher-Haus in St. Wolfgang.
3.30 p.m.: Team-Marathon in the Michael-Pacher-Haus in St. Wolfgang.
